- In the case of Vilnius University (VU), all the information about the examinations (i.e. the subject of the studies, the composition of the examination board, place, date and time) have to be submitted to the administrator of the doctoral studies Kristina Aponienė at least three days before the examination by e-mail <u>kristina.aponiene@ff.vu.lt</u>. An order of the Dean of the Faculty of Physics is prepared based on your request.
- In the case of Center of Physical and Technological Sciences (FTMC), all the information about the examinations (i.e. the subject of the studies, the composition of the examination board, place, date and time) have to be submitted to the information administrator Rasa Kromkutė at least three days before the examination by e-mail <u>rasa.kromkute@ftmc.lt</u>. An order of the Director of the Center for Physical and Technological Sciences is prepared based on your request.
- A record of each taken examination has to be filed in the doctoral programme <u>examinations report</u>, where the assessment received is written and signed by all the members of the board. Doctoral students enrolled from 2022 onwards do not need to fill in an examination protocol paper form. The examination results are entered directly into the DVS AVILYS.
- The doctoral programme examination report must be brought to the VU Department for Doctoral and Postdoctoral Studies after passing all the examinations. This remains for those who were enrolled before 2022.
